HSA Testing Tips



This month schools in the Castle Complex will be involved in Hawaii State Assessment Standardized Testing (HSA). Standardized tests are created to see how students from one school or class compare to other students across the city, state, or country. They give educators a common standard to measure student performance.

Parent Testing Tips:

- ◆ Make sure your child gets a good night's sleep.
- ◆ Provide a good breakfast.
- ◆ Don't be too anxious. Say, "This test is important. I know you will try hard and do your best." Your confidence will be contagious.
- ◆ Are you ready? Check to make sure your child has the correct kind of pencils, calculator, or other supplies needed for the test.
- ◆ Keep things in focus. Standardized tests are just one of the ways schools evaluate children's abilities. Don't believe, or let your child believe, that poor test results mark him or her as a failure.
