Don't Forget to Register for Kindergarten Now!

If you haven't registered for kindergarten yet, now is the time! If your child was born in 2003, register at your school office with the following required documents:

- Original or certified copy of birth certificate.
- Original Form 14 Health Card from your child's doctor.
- Verification of a TB test within a year before entering school.
- Proof of current local address, such as a telephone or cable bill.

FIREWORKS SAFETY TIPS

Fireworks and celebrations go together, especially during the Fourth of July. But fireworks can be dangerous, causing serious burn and eye injuries.

Be sure to follow these important safety tips:

- * Never allow small children to play with or ignite fireworks.
- * Read and follow all warnings and instructions.
- * Be sure other people are out of range before lighting fireworks.
- * Only light fireworks on a smooth, flat surface away from the house, dry leaves, and flammable materials.
- * Never shoot fireworks in metal or glass containers.
- * Never try to relight fireworks that have not fully functioned.
- Keep a bucket of water handy in case of a malfunction or fire
